



## High School / Jr. High Arrival and Drop-off

Morning drop-off / arrival for Mohawk Jr./Sr. High School is from 7:45am-8:00am. The tardy bell rings at 8:00am, students arriving after 8:00am will need to report to the office and sign in.

The picture above shows the parking lot. The red line represents student drivers. The blue line represents parents or guardians dropping students off. We have opened up a rear entrance/exit to the student parking lot and are changing the arrival, departure, and drop-off procedures in order to improve traffic flow and student safety.

Students driving to school will enter the Mohawk campus at the North entrance on 231 at the electronic marquee. Students will proceed to the new rear entrance of the student parking lot and will turn right into the parking lot. Parents will be exiting at this same point so students should proceed with caution.

Parents or guardians dropping students off will also enter the Mohawk campus at the North entrance on 231 at the electronic marquee. They will make the first right and then the first left into the student parking lot. They may drop off anywhere along the curb, but should not park along the curb. They will then use the new exit at the rear of the student parking lot and turn left. Parents needing to drop-off elementary students can then turn left again toward the elementary side and follow those drop-off procedures.

## High School / Jr. High Afternoon Departure and Pick-up

Students are dismissed at 3:00pm. All students will exit the new rear entrance of the parking lot. They should be cautious and courteous.

Parents will enter the front of the lot just as in the morning drop off. Parents arriving early will park and wait in the parking lot. Please park in designated parking places only. There will be someone on duty to direct traffic. Please follow our procedures and their instructions as they are there to insure a safe and orderly pick-up.
