Dear Parent,

The health and well-being of your child is very important. A healthy child is better able to learn. The nursing staff at your school places the health and well-being of every student as a priority and encourages parents to take their children to seek medical attention during sick times, for regular check-ups and specialist appointments.

When your child has been to see a private provider or specialist, many times that office will provide a “visit summary” after each appointment. We encourage you to get a copy of that visit and share that important information with your school nurse. It will allow us to better understand and care for your child while they are at school. It also decreases the confusion you may have after a visit when trying to remember all that was said. We are an excellent resource for you with additional information which you can then discuss with the health care provider.
