SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 5748.02 of the Ohio Revised Code as amended (the "Act") a levy of an additional annual tax for the purpose of the current expenses on the school district income of individuals and estates is hereby proposed and it is hereby determined to proceed with the submission to the electors of the school district the question of levying an income tax of three-quarters percent (0.75%) per annum on the school district income of individuals and of estates for the purpose of current expenses for six years at the election to be held on May 5, 2009. Said tax, if approved by the electors, shall be effective January 1, 2010.

The income subject to the proposed tax is taxable income of individuals and estates as defined in divisions (E)(1)(A) and (2) of Section 5748.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.
